January 2017 - Today, Software Developer at Accenture, Vienna / Austria

I liaise directly with the client, an Austrian Health Care Insurance company, in a Scrum Team as a Java Developer. Through developing backend batch processes for end-of-day processing and creating front-end application services used internally, I contribute to transforming, digitalising and modernising the company. Teaming up with the architects, I enable the design of concepts and as a Scrum developer I have been developing through every stage of the development cycle during our multiple releases of the software so far.

June 2017 - Today, Port To Success

Starting off as a "just-for-fun" project on the side, I designed, created and developed a Java-based web application and database solution, which is now used by upper management of an enterprise group in ancillary construction trades and environment engineering. The modules currently released into production consist of reporting & controlling, personnel database and generation of weekly and monthly reports.

For three summers in a row I mentored during GSOC where I was responsible for guiding students through the coding process, reviewing and merging code on Github and helped students when they got stuck. The projects included web application for Peace Corps Volunteers in Guyana and an educational iOS game to empower pre-adolescents. I still frequently contribute to Open Source projects.
